Notifying Targeted Individuals

Sentinel uses advanced and proven electronic monitoring technology to monitor the location of both the offender and the targeted individual. Through our DVM Program, the targeted individual voluntarily carries a small GPS tracking device while the offender is required to wear a court-ordered GPS ankle-worn device at all times. Sentinel is then able to create a mobile exclusion zone around the targeted individual by simultaneously monitoring both devices at the same time.

Should the offender approach or enter the mobile exclusion zone, Sentinel notifies the intended victim and police. Specially trained operators in Sentinel's 24/7/365 National Monitoring Center notify the targeted individual and law enforcement of the potential breach enabling them to execute a predetermined emergency safety action plan quickly and avoid potential contact with the offender.

Courts that require domestic violence offenders to wear GPS tracking devices as a condition of release also benefit from knowing that Sentinel's Domestic Violence Monitoring Program will notify the targeted individual and provide them with the valuable time needed to find a safe location in the event that the offender attempts to come into physical contact with them. Ultimately, this monitoring program allows survivors of domestic violence to live with a greater sense of security as they begin re-building their lives.
